M74 West Renewable Energy Park

Request under Regulation 19 of The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017 for additional information relating to the grid connection

On behalf of M74 West LTD, which is a fully owned subsidiary of Renewco Power Limited, please find enclosed a response to your request under Regulation 19 of The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017 for additional information on the environmental effects of the grid connection for the M74 West Renewable Energy Park, including in combination with the generating station and considering any cumulative effects.

The enclosed report provides supplementary clarification, drawing on the already submitted Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and supporting environmental information already, to demonstrate that the environmental effects of the grid connection have been considered to a degree that is proportionate, transparent and sufficient to inform decision-making. In particular, the report provides the following information in response to the Regulation 19 request:

- a proportionate assessment of the potential for likely significant environmental effects arising from the grid connection when considered by itself;
- an assessment of the combined effects of the Wind Farm and the grid connection, where both elements together give rise to effects on the same environmental receptor; and
- an assessment of cumulative effects where both the proposed Wind Farm and the grid connection infrastructure are likely to have an impact on the same receptor.

In accordance with Regulation 20 of The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017, a paper copy of the additional information and all other application documents will be made available to view at the publicly accessible The Old Schoolhouse,

Abington. The additional information shall also be advertised via a notice placed in the local press, in the Edinburgh Gazette and on the project website at <https://www.renewcopower.com/portfolio/united-kingdom/uk-projects/m74-west-renewable-energy-park/>. Furthermore, notice of the additional information shall be served upon the planning authority and all consultees.
